In accordance with Federal Regulations, Habitat for Humanity International, and our Liability Insurance with Lockton Insurance (HfHI).

Build Site Minor Volunteers (Ages 16 and 17):

MAY NOT:

In accordance with Federal Regulations, Habitat for Humanity International, and our Liability Insurance with Lockton Insurance (HfHI).

- May not participate in blitz builds/parking lot builds/panel builds.
- May not engage in activities where the youth could be exposed to asbestos or lead paint hazards.
- May not engage in any Designated Hazardous Activities.
- May not operate Power-Driven Machinery designated as hazardous by the U.S. Secretary of Labor such as saws, wood chippers, woodworking machines or shearing machines, etc.

MAY:

In accordance with Federal Regulations, Habitat for Humanity International, and our Liability Insurance with Lockton Insurance (HfHI).

- Engage in any new construction or rehab activities allowed for youth ages 14 and 15.
- Be present on an active construction site (Build Site) or perform general construction or repair work.
- Load or unload materials on or off of trucks.
- Operate Power-Driven Machinery such as lawnmowers. (Please refer to the "May Not" list!)
- Paint, on or off-site.
